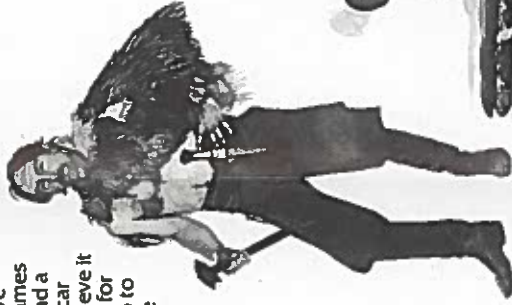


Beau Hickory.
